CPS's Big Move!

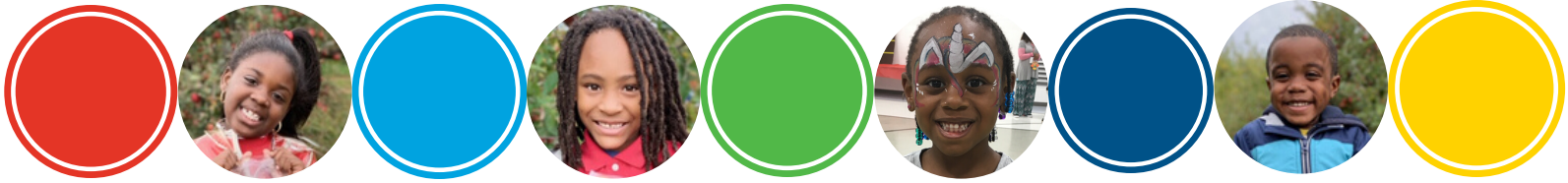

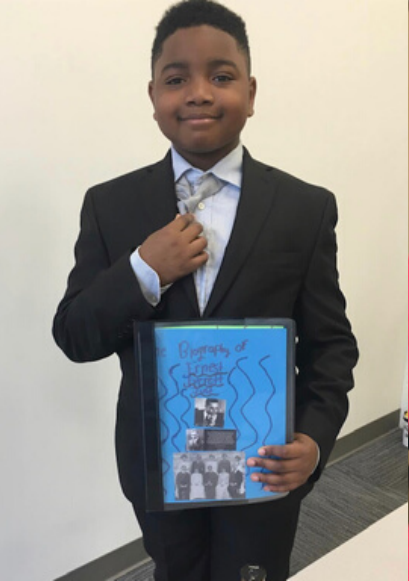
