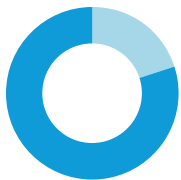

80% of 4th and 5th graders finished the year reading at or above grade level (over 45% higher than the School District of Philadelphia average)

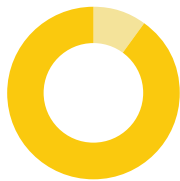


75% of 4th and 5th graders finished the year grade level proficient in Math (over 50% higher than the School District of Philadelphia average)

# Year in Review

## Reaccreditation

During the 2022-23 school year, CPS successfully obtained re-accreditation from the Pennsylvania Association of Independent Schools (PAIS), a rigorous, standards-based evaluation that included an extensive self-study and a professional peer review administered by teachers and administrators from other PAIS member institutions. The PAIS visiting committee's report commended our community's "unyielding commitment and passion" for the CPS mission, our student- and family-first approach, and our fundraising efforts that secured our school building on Glenwood Avenue and continue to keep CPS an accessible, high-quality option for families regardless of financial means.

This achievement underscores our unwavering commitment to effectively executing our mission and providing an outstanding learning environment, and marks a moment of immense pride for our entire school community. A big thank you to all the administrators, faculty and staff members, trustees,

parents, and friends who contributed to this important accomplishment.

## Science Fair

CPS proudly unveiled its first science fair with resounding success. Students, teachers, parents, and friends gathered to learn from the impressive student projects that spanned various scientific disciplines, embodying the essence of "curiosity-driven learning". The event demonstrated the power of fostering scientific inquiry and critical thinking in young minds.

From Pre-K to 2nd grade, our youngest learners collaborated within their classrooms, while their 3rd through 5th grade counterparts formed focused groups to refine their projects. Together, they formulated "scientific questions," crafting hypotheses and curating project boards once their experiments took shape. On the day of the fair, we had the privilege of hosting Tshelo Yane, a local bioengineer and data analyst, who shared firsthand insights into the life of a scientist.

## Celebrate CPS 2023

Our annual spring gala, Celebrate CPS, encapsulates the spirit, enthusiasm, and shared commitment of our steadfast community. On May 19, 2023, we honored Jeffrey T. Sultanik and Dr. Tobo Houessou-Adin for their profound impact on the CPS community. ### Alumni Trip to DC

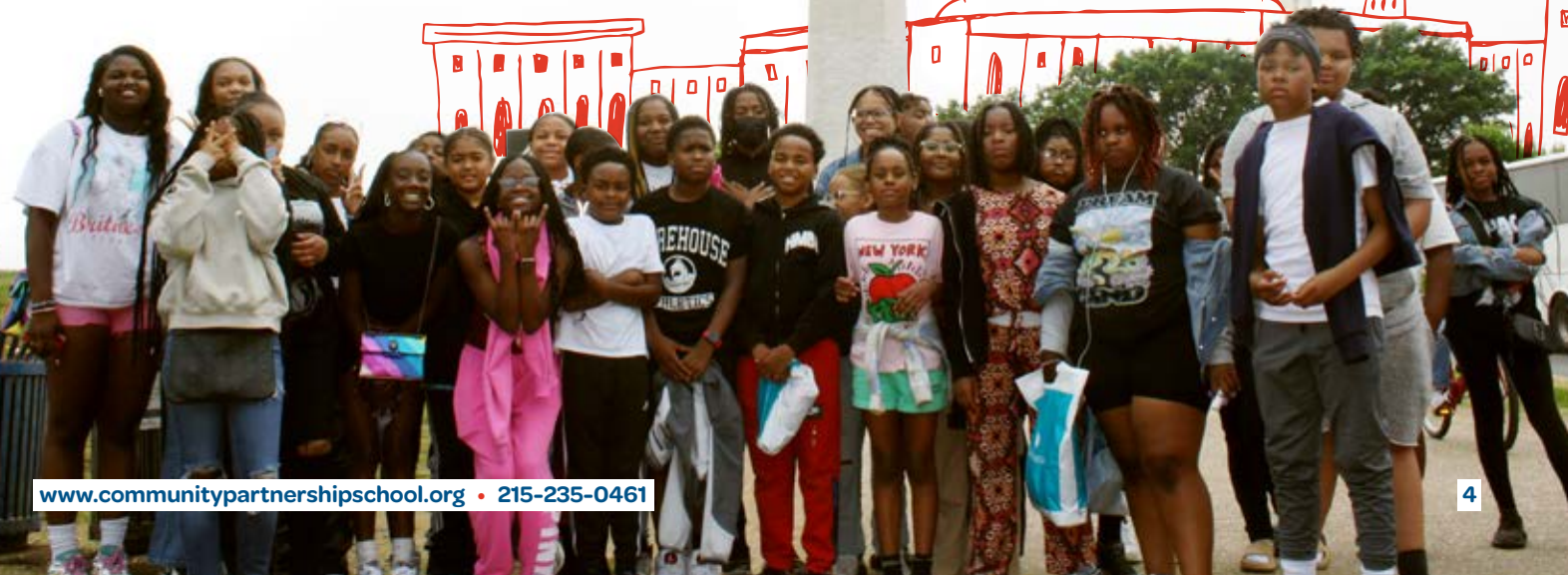
